## Envisaged outcomes as set in proposal

Reached
1 Five unemployed youths from the disadvantaged areas are empowered
5
and given the opportunity to earn a stipend
2 Four hundred children are given the opportunity to be physical active throughout the year and have the opportunity to learn new sporting skills due to the appointment of the 5 new youth sport leaders

3 At least 3000 children are motivated to be physically active and gain knowledge regarding Olympic Education and Olympism through knowledge carried over by the rest of the youth sport leaders.

4 At least 300 participants have the opportunity to participate in the Olympic Day event

198 boys +335 girls $=533$

1829 boys + 6737 girls = 8566

5 Youth Sport Leaders have the opportunity in organising the Olympic Day
2 Olympic Days, 1 Peace Day as empowerment for Event Management.

6 Spreading the Olympic Spirit to at least another 1500 indirect 3558 beneficiaries
